Agenda Item No. 1

To confirm the minutes of the last meeting of IQAC held on June 28, 2017 (minutes already circulated on July 3, 2017).

To consider the introduction of the course of **Total Quality Management (TQM)** in the category of open electives across all departments of the university, except those where the course is already running.

Note: As per the NAAC norms, IQAC is committed to spread the culture of quality in the university. To enable and empower the students to think systematically on various issues relating to quality in university and professional life, it is considered important to expose them to the formal quality tools and processes. In this direction, it is felt that the students be offered a course on Total Quality Management which has relevance in all the disciplines of study. Engineering and Management programmes in a large number of institutions are already offering this course. The inclusion of the course will enrich the inter-disciplinary content of the curricula of different departments.

Agenda Item No.5

To consider extension of the scope of Academic Audit to Library, Student Welfare activities (DSW office) and placements (CRC) relating to MRIU.

Agenda Item No.6

To consider the introduction of regular **Winter School on Quality** for faculty on an annual basis.

Note: As a new quality initiative, it is proposed that a Winter School be organized for faculty every year for 3-5 days. Winter school for faculty is among the best institutional practices and are run by several higher education institutions including Centre for Environmental Planning and Technology (CEPT), Ahmedabad, University of Sydney and T.A. Pai Management Institute, Karnataka.

Winter and summer school of faculty are also recognized under AICTE. The main purpose of the Winter School on Quality is to expose the faculty members to the tools, techniques, processes and the best practices relating to different aspects of quality in academics including academic administration. The School is proposed to be organized for 3 days prior to the conduct of end-semester examinations (preparatory holidays) in November/December every year for a limited number of participants.
