

MRNAT' 23 Phase II Offline Mode Student Guidelines

- 1. The candidates need to reach the exam venue latest by 9.30 AM on the test day (April 23, Sunday)
- 2. The students need to show their government-authorized identity card (Aadhar card/ PAN card/Driver's License/ Voter ID/Passport etc) and respective Hall tickets (download from: manavrachna.edu.in) at the gate for procuring entry to the venue.
- 3. Candidates need to report at the Registration Counters latest by 9.30 AM to mark their attendance and get their hall ticket/ ID proofs cross-verified
- 4. Our representatives would then guide the candidates to their respective assessment labs and assign computer systems to appear for the examination.
- 5. After the completion of the MRNAT test, the candidates would be ushered to their assigned waiting arenas for GD/PI sessions, according to their group numbers.

Few pointers to be noted (By students opting for the offline mode of MRNAT)

- 1. Students would be allowed to only carry a transparent water bottle, a small-sized hand sanitizer, a pen and an A4-sized blank paper with them to the examination labs.
- 2. For Undergraduate Applicants: The test would be of 90 minutes and comprise 75 multiplechoice questions, with 25 questions each on Arithmetic and Logical Reasoning, General Awareness and General English
- 3. For Postgraduate Applicants: The test would be of 90 minutes and comprise 45 multiple-choice questions, with 15 questions (each on Arithmetic and Logical Reasoning, General Awareness and General English) and 30 questions related to the corresponding programs the candidates have applied for.
- 4. The MRNAT exam and allied GD/PI sessions would begin at 10:00 AM
- 5. Students wanting to avail of our pick-and-drop shuttle services (ONLY VALID FOR MANAV RACHNA CAMPUS, FARIDABAD) from Badkal Mor Metro station, can do the same as per the following service schedule:
 - a. For students appearing for the morning session exam, three transport slots are available (**for pick-up only**) 8:15 AM, 8:45 AM and 9:15 AM.
 - b. The drop slots would be provided as per available seats after the morning session exams are over from Gate No. 2
