The Chairperson, then invited the experts to share their views about what can be built from what they heard, in this multidimensional institution. He called upon all experts as follows:

a) Mr Abhijit Jayanti, Chairman & Managing Trustee-OLIVE Foundation Trust Hyderabad

The three very important points onto which the attention was drawn upon were:

- Job is not the end and certainly not just to fulfill personnel aspirations but rather it is for understanding others aspirations. In academic institutions, Professors when talk to students, they come to know about their aspirations and in turn help them to achieve it Hence, education should be <u>student centric.</u>
- (ii) Secondly, in India, there is lack of sincere approach and all is jugarr. These days less time is invested in learning and just for few 1000s, job jumping happens. Hence, entire culture is to be corrected and students need to be made sensitive about <u>Life Learning</u>.
- (iii) Thirdly, the academic institutions and industry work in silos, so when industry is ready to share their problems and shell out cash, then why work in silos. Hence, <u>industry exposure</u> must be given to faculty members.

b) Ms Ravneet Kaur, Vice-President, iNICU Medical Private Limited, Delhi.

Being a successful entrepreneur, with a firm being just 4 yrs old and being first industry sponsored student of CSIR, Madam Ravneet shared with the house that her firm has collaboration with IIIT, Delhi and faculty members are involved. The product being manufactured requires Lab Data, Clinical Data to be processes for certain predictions and projections, and for this the faculty with mathematical skills was associated for modeling assignments. Students were given real time projects and they do join with lots of enthusiasm but this does not sustain for long. The industry wants them to learn and perform but the commitment is low. With the expanding business in US, Europe and elsewhere, more and more workforce is required and industry looks up to students graduating within the country. Hence, student engagement is important.

The chairperson added that an institution is built based on a mechanism design, the one which helps it to achieve what is desired.



h) Dr. Raja Mugasi Mangalam, CEO-Genotypic Technology Bangalore.

Dr Raja said that we must encourage entrepreneurship very early in students. He said he can help in mentoring students how to think of an idea, how to develop the idea and sell the idea for investment.
