I am desired to refer to your letter dated 22.9.2006 accepting the terms and conditions contained in this Ministry's letter of even No. Dated 22.9.2006 and furnishing PBG No.3179ILG000206 dated 19.9.2006 for Rs.200 lakhs valid upto 19.9.2011 and an additional PBG No.3179ILG000306 dated 19.9.2006 for Rs.100 lakhs valid upto 19.9.2007 issued by the Punjab National Bank, Old Faridabad, and to convey the formal permission of the Central Government to M.R. Education Society, u/s 10A(4) of the Dentists (Amendment) Act, 1993 to establish a new dental college, 'Manav Rachana Dental College', at Faridabad, with an annual admission capacity of 100 students in BDS Course for the academic Session 2006-2007.
