IPR Team, Manav Rachna University organized an IP Awareness Session on ‘**Law of Patents**’ for the Faculty of Management and Commerce, Faculty of Applied Sciences and Faculty of Education on **10th October 2019**, with a view to enhance the awareness about protecting one's innovative ideas through Intellectual Property. The speaker of the session was Mr. Amit Kumar, Assistant Professor, Faculty of Law, Manav Rachna University.

The resource person shared his opinion that IPR provides rewards and recognition to the inventors for their research, designs, discoveries, inventions, etc. He shared his knowledge about types of Intellectual Properties recognised under TRIPs like copyright, trademarks, geographical indications, industrial designs, patents, integrated circuits and trade secrets. Mr. Amit introduced the faculty members to the various kinds of Intellectual Property Rights, Patentable and Non-patentable items, types of Patents, Scope of patents and Patentability criteria. He gave a detailed view about the novelty and inventiveness of a technology, inventive step or non – obviousness and the stages from filing of patent to the grant of patent through real-time examples.
