IPR Team, Manav Rachna University organized an IP Awareness Session on '**Law of Patent**' for the Faculty of Mechanical Engineering and the Faculty of Electronics and Communication Engineering on **31st October 2019** with a view to sensitize all the participants about Intellectual Property Rights and their protection, identifying protectable innovations. The speaker of the session was Mr. Amit Kumar, Assistant Professor at Faculty of Law, Manav Rachna University.

The speaker gave an opinion that IPR provides rewards and recognition to inventors/contributors for their research, designs, discoveries, inventions, etc. He shared his knowledge about types of Intellectual Properties being recognised under TRIPs like Copyright, Trademarks, Geographical indications, Industrial designs, Patents, Integrated Circuits and Trade Secrets. He explains about different kinds of intellectual property rights, patentable and non-patentable items, types of patent, scope of patent and patentability criteria. A detailed understanding of the complete process of filing the Patent application, Copyright application, Trademark application, Design application and the Scheme for Facilitating Start-ups Intellectual Property Protection was given.
