IPR Team, Manav Rachna University organized an IP Awareness Session on 'Law of Patent' for Faculty of Computer Science & Technology on 14th November 2019, to create awareness among the faculty members about the patent system in India and provide user friendly guidelines for obtaining and maintaining patents under the existing Patent laws.

The speaker of the session was Mr. Amit Kumar, Assistant Professor, Faculty of Law, Manav Rachna University. He began the lecture with an explanation of the different types of Intellectual Property Rights, sharing his opinion that IPR provides rewards and recognition to the inventor/contributor for their research, designs, discoveries, inventions, etc. He shared his knowledge about the various types of Intellectual Property recognised under TRIPs like copyright, trademarks, geographical indications, industrial designs, patents, integrated circuits and trade secrets. The speaker explained about different kinds of intellectual property rights, patentable and non-patentable items, types of patent, scope of patent and patentability criteria. The knowledge about the novelty and inventiveness of technology, inventive step or non-obviousness and stages from filing to the grant of patent was delivered, citing real life examples.

The session was very interactive and the speaker invoked a lot of queries in the audience, leading to an informative and meaningful session for all the participants as each one of them got their well-justified answers.
