

Online Exam Guidelines

Kindly Ensure:

- 1. An internet connectivity of at least 512 kbps.
- 2. To install the latest version of Mozilla Firefox or Google Chrome on Windows and MAC OS.
- 3. That the pop-up blocker is disabled by enabling the 'Disable Pop Up Blocker' option from your device settings
- 4. To uninstall any third-party software installed on the system for the webcam before starting the test.
- 5. To check the webcam before the test. It should be in working condition.
- 6. To turn off chat applications (Google Talk, Yahoo, Messenger, etc.), antivirus updates, auto updates, screen savers, and other notifications.
- 7. To provide permission for your webcam and microphone; and access to capture the screen. Ensure sufficient lights in the room.
- 8. To never navigate away from the test window during the test
- 9. To never use a mobile phone, earphone, calculator, or any other electronic device during the exam.
- 10. To note that the system will detect suspicious activities (additional people in the room, use of mobile phones/calculators/books, etc.) and report such activities to the authorities.
- 11. To never press the 'F5' key while giving the test, as this will make the test end suddenly and you will not be able to continue the test.
- 12. That in case of your computer system shutting down due to power shortage or technical error, you don't panic. Simply restart your computer and resume your test from wherever you left. Your previous answers would have been saved, and you would not need to redo them once again.
- 13. To keep your Aadhar Card/ Pan Card/Driver's Licence / Passport handy before beginning the test. You need to log in to the test account through your registered ID when asked by the computer to do so.
